As per guidelines received from the Special Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Department of Disaster Management & Civil Defence vide No.858(23)-DMCD-11017(99)/35/2017, dt.22.04.2022, application is invited in the prescribed format for undergoing Aapada Mitra Volunteers' training under Disaster Management and Civil Defence Department from eligible candidates fitting the criteria as given below :

- Age group between 18 and 40 years/ age for ex-army officer, retired medical professionals, civil engineers may be relaxed.
- 2. Must be a resident of the concerned district.
- 3. Education: at least 7<sup>th</sup> Standard Pass.
- 4. Be in good physical, mental and emotional health (Medical Fitness Certicate mandatory)
- 5. Preference would be given to ex-servicemen, personnel from Fire Services, Civil Defence and Home Guards.Volunteers from NYKS, NCC, NSS and Bharat Scouts & Guides may also apply.
- 6. State Govt. may encourage greater involvement and leadership of women volunteer in Disaster Risk Management.
- 7. Prior experience of volunteering in disaster response operations would be preferable.

Application must be submitted to the respective Blocks for Block areas and to the DM Office for Municipality area by 17/05/2022 upto 5:00 PM.
